This form is for use by owners of aircraft that do not have noise certification who wish to apply for a noise certification exemption under Regulation 9A(2)(b) of the Air Navigation (Aircraft Noise) Regulations 1984. Aircraft are granted this permit to allow participation in airshows. Maintenance, positioning and training flights for purposes of participation in an airshow are also permitted under a historical aircraft permit.
