

Thank you for the opportunity to provide a submission on the development of the NAPS.

My main concern is that allowing unrestricted 24-hour operations of passenger and freight aircraft over Canberra will reduce the quality of life of those who live below the flight paths. Residents MUST be consulted further on the need for an airport curfew and other safeguards before such a proposal are approved.

If the number of flights has to be increased to Canberra Airport, and at night, then I suggest that a curfew be set for 10pm – 6am. Sydney has a curfew. To not give Canberra one would be in effect labeling Canberra residents as second class Australians.
