In relation to the issues paper on aviation policy I wish to express my view as a resident of Seven Hills Queensland 4170.

This suburb, at times, might be considered to have a unique and valuable amenity to the residents but this is persistently destroyed by aircraft noise.

Day time and night time noise can be so disruptive as to hinder conversation at the very least and to completely interrupt sleep at the worst.

Aircraft noise makes life unbearable because the planes come across Seven Hills at intervals of 3~4 minutes for hours upon hours at all times of day and night.

Of particular concern are the late nighttime freight planes which are so loud sleep is interrupted every time one of these flies over in the middle of the night; at times such as 1am or 2am.

The situation is dreadful and the government would be wise to consider night curfews as well as compensation for residents to insulate our homes and double glaze windows.

I as a permanent owner occupier urge the government to make changes to the current situation and give Seven Hills back some peace and quiet.
