**Circumstances Leading to Request:** Tigerair Australia flight TT263 (Sydney to Melbourne) was fully boarded when an engineering fault was detected. A dispensation was approved to depart no later than 11:30pm. There were 163 passengers and six crew members on board. The aircraft departed at 11:26pm.

**CIRCUMSTANCES LEADING TO REQUEST**

Sydney Airport Corporation Limited has applied for a blanket runway dispensation to transfer permitted curfew traffic to the northern end of runway 16R/34L.

This request is to undertake essential construction works on runways 16R/34L and taxiways within this runway.

The northern end of runway 16R/34L is normally closed to aircraft movements during curfew, but is required to be opened to any permitted aircraft during curfew for 30 nights only during the period of 1 July to 31 December 2018.

Approval was given on the condition that the community living immediately to the north of the Airport were advised of the changes in curfew operations.

**REASONS FOR APPROVAL**

The runway works constitute an upgrade and are necessary for the continued safe operation of the Airport. This work constitutes 'exceptional circumstances', as listed in paragraph 7 of the Sydney Airport Curfew (Dispensation) Guideline 2016, which covers the possible unavailability of the main north-south runway due to maintenance.
