The Cavenagh Street shade structure project has been completed, providing a cool space and amenity in the city


Darwin's new 450 bay carpark was built in 2019 and is now in operation


Darwin's Urban Living Lab was established in 2019 and the first heat mitigation projects were completed in 2019 using cutting edge science


2019 Street Art Festival continues to curate public art in city laneways and streets


Education and Community Precinct's Masterplan for a new student campus is finalised and construction to begin in 2020


Switching on Darwin fitted 138 CCTVs, 910 smart LED streetlights, microclimate monitoring systems and public wifi


150 full time jobs created to rollout Switching on Darwin project and 3 ongoing jobs


The Civic and State Square Masterplan was completed in 2019


10 Australian Government jobs transferred from Canberra to Darwin in 2019


The second NT's Designated Area of Migration Agreement resulted in 52 businesses entering labour agreements


Darwin's Living Lab held its inaugural Science Symposium in December 2019


NT already seeing a 25% rise in international student numbers between 2018 and 2019


Larrakia Hosts engaged 230 organisations and visited 14 schools reaching 2500 students


7000 trees planted in CBD in 2019


Carpark construction resulted in 280 local jobs and Indigenous employment of 9%
