



2.1 Arts and Cultural Development grant funding from 1 July 2014 to 30 June 2016

Agencies are required to publish details of their individual grants on their website no later than 14 working days after the funding agreement for the grant takes effect.

A grant is a conditional transfer of resources from the Australian Government to a recipient for a specified purpose. Grants are directed at assisting recipients to achieve their own goals whilst also supporting Australian Government policy objectives.

The then Ministry for The Arts was transferred from the Attorney General's Department in September 2015. For completeness, all grants awarded from 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2016 are published here.
