CIRCULAR NO. 0-8-1

COMPLIANCE PLATES FOR VEHICLES NOT DESIGNED PRIMARILY FOR ROAD
OPERATION

State and Territory registering authorities have advised the Board that until further notice, they will not require Compliance Plates to be affixed to tractors, road plant and other such vehicles not designed primarily for road operation.

2. This decision applies, in particular, to agricultural equipment, earth moving, road making and maintenance plant, mobile cranes, fork lift trucks, straddle trucks and similar equipment, provided the basis of such vehicles is not a conventional truck chassis.

3. Manufacturers should note that this decision relates only to matter of affixing of Compliance Plates to this class of vehicle and does not imply a relaxation of any other requirement applicable to such vehicles under State or Territory legislation.
