## Pipeline construction to kick off

The Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications, Sport and the Arts (the Department) and its partner Shoalhaven City Council (SCC) are making good progress in delivering the new water pipeline for Jervis Bay Territory (JBT).

Quickway Constructions has been selected by SCC to deliver this important project, which will provide the local community with a new water main, connecting the reservoir at Vincentia to the Stoney Creek Reservoir in JBT. Once completed, the pipeline will provide a more sustainable water source for the community, as well as improving potable water quality and reliability to the JBT community.

With experience constructing transport and utilities infrastructure across Australia, and an understanding of the distinct environmental and cultural needs of the JBT, Quickway will work with the Department and the Council to keep disruptions to a minimum throughout these works.

SCC is writing to residents and property occupants with further information about the upcoming works which will commence shortly, and their impacts, including notifications about a temporary increase in truck movements, noise generation and road works with appropriate traffic management controls.

Construction works will start in the New South Wales area of the pipeline. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this important project. Further details regarding the schedule will be provided as the works progress, including the timeline of works into the JBT and more information on local impacts.
