Give us your views on Jervis Bay School

To make sure Jervis Bay School continues to meet the unique needs of the Jervis Bay Territory (JBT) community, the department is reviewing how the school is working – including its cultural, social and educational value - through a routine evaluation process.

Kyma Group, a majority Aboriginal-owned consultancy with strong experience working alongside First Nations communities, has been engaged to lead this review. In line with Australian Government policy, they will carry out a Value for Investment evaluation, looking at how the school delivers across financial, cultural and community outcomes.

The team will be visiting Jervis Bay Territory from 18 to 20 November to hear directly from local residents, school staff and the Wreck Bay Aboriginal Community Council (WBACC).

Consultation will include face-to-face interviews, a community consultation workshop and virtual meetings. Everyone is welcome to share their views.
