Practical Driving Assessments (P-Plate) – 15 JULY 2026

Learner drivers eligible to upgrade from a Learner 'L' Plate to Provisional 'P' Plate licence can take a practical driving assessment on **Wednesday 15 JULY 2026**. The assessment is an on-road test that evaluates your hazard perception, decision-making and overall driving skills.

Eligibility and requirements:

- Pay the applicable fee of \$129.00
- Be at least 17 years of age
- Have held a Learner Driver licence for 12 months, or 6 months if aged 25 years or over
- Completed Hazard Perception Test online prior to test
- Provide a roadworthy vehicle for the driving test (a vehicle is not supplied)
- Provide a completed Logbook with a record of the minimum driving hours required:
 - Under 25 – minimum of 90 Day hours and 10 Night hours
 - 25 years over – minimum 45 Day hours and 5 Night hours.

Please note: If the required driving hours are not completed in the Logbook, the driving test will not be conducted.

Road Ready Pre-Learner Licence Course – 16 JULY 2026

Eligible JBT residents can complete the Road Ready Pre-Learner Licence Course on **Thursday 16 JULY 2026**. The course will be held from 10am-3pm in the JBT Admin Building Upstairs Boardroom. The course introduces key concepts for new drivers before obtaining a Learner Licence.

Eligibility and requirements:

- Pay the applicable fee of \$215.00 - if the applicant is not enrolled in school
- The course is free for students currently enrolled in school. Proof of school enrolment must be supplied
- Be at least 15 years and 9 months of age
- Provide full proof of identity - 100 points
- Provide proof of residency in the JBT.
