

Key Points:

- 1. The terms of seven of the 12 serving Infrastructure Australia (IA) Board members, including the Chair, will end between 31 July 2021 and 30 November 2021, broadly staggered into two groups (see <u>Attachment A</u>).
- 2. The IA Board is comprised of 12 members, nine of whom are nominated by the Commonwealth. All seven outgoing members in 2021 are Commonwealth nominees. Three State/Territory nominated positions will expire in November 2022.



Objectives

- 7. Board Composition:
 - a. The *Infrastructure Australia Act 2008* (IA Act) requires Board candidates to have knowledge or experience covering the functions of IA. Collectively, it is desirable to have a broad spread of experience across the members.
 - b. The Cabinet Handbook requires that proposals for board appointments pay due regard to gender balance and to an appropriate geographical balance. In the case of IA, an appropriate geographical balance is likely to include coverage of each state, and northern and regional Australia, where possible.

8. At least five of the appointments, including the Chair, are legislatively required to have relevant private sector experience. At least four of the appointments will need to be women to meet the Government's board gender diversity target. A visualisation of the IA Board composition is at <u>Attachment B</u>.



- 11. Appointment terms can be set to support the aim of regular renewal of members each year, for instance, by setting a shortened two-year term for a portion of the reappointments.

- 16. As the IA Board positions are significant government appointments, the Prime Minister, or at his discretion, the Cabinet needs to approve the appointments following your recommendation.

- 19. The Department proposes to prepare a second briefing covering the December 2021 appointments after completion of the first tranche of appointments, to ensure we take account of any additional developments.

Background:

- 21. Section 8(1) of the IA Act provides you with the authority to appoint members to the Board.
- 22. The IA Board is comprised of 12 members, nine of whom are nominated by the Commonwealth, five of which, including the Chair, are to have experience relevant to the functions of IA and in the private sector, and one member must have experience in local government. The remaining three members are nominated by agreement between state and territory governments.
- 23. Experience in the following sectors are highly desirable for the current functions of IA: transport, water, energy, communications, health, education, economics, planning and engineering.
- 24. Board members may be appointed for a maximum term of three years, but may be reappointed for further terms.
- 25. In addition to the seven terms ending in 2021, the balance of the incumbent Board member terms will end in 2022.





- 3. Your agreement to an extension is sought until formal appointments are approved by the Prime Minister or Cabinet.
- 4. A quorum of eight members is required for each Board meeting. If you choose not to extend any appointments, the IA Board will continue with 10 members. This allows the IA Board to continue to operate if some appointees are unable to attend a board meeting.
- The appointment guidelines in the Cabinet Handbook allow you to extend the tenure of members for up to three months without the need to consult with the Prime Minister.
