We've run this engagement process through our procurement area and they have advised it would be more appropriate to proceed through the existing Deed of Standing Offer that EY have with the Commonwealth. This would facilitate our tight timeframes which could otherwise take up to a week to process. Engaging through the Deed reduces the risk profile and avoids the need for the Department to develop additional assessment documents for significant procurements as required under the Commonwealth Procurement Rules.

EY should be familiar with engagements through the Deed. We have been advised that the attached <u>Schedule 3: Official Order (work order)</u> will need sign-off between DoCA and EY. The work order has been filled in from our end, having extracted all relevant information from the engagement letter from the start of Appendix A up to the "Information Requirements" (excluded), as we consider the remaining sections would be covered under the Deed (the exceptions being the Conflicts of Interest and Additional Terms and Conditions sections which have been included in the work order). Appendix B (supplementary) and C (covered through the Deed) have also been excluded.

We have also been advised that <u>Schedule 4: Notice of Inclusion Form</u> should be completed to confirm DoCA as one the recipient parties using the Deed (as opposed to the Deed's representative, the Department of Finance). This has also been filled in our end.

The work order and notice of inclusion form have been attached for your review and sign-off. Note that highlighted areas will need to be updated on your end. The Deed has also been attached for your reference.

Apologies for the late change in approach. Happy to discuss this further.

Subject to signing by both EY and DoCA, this will allow the work to commence this week and we can provide EY with our initial set of documents. Current suggestion for the project name is 'Project Enhance' unless you have a better idea?

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SCHEDULE 3 OFFICIAL ORDER

Official Order number DCON/18/79

1. Context

This Official Order is issued and agreed pursuant to and subject to the terms and conditions of the Deed between Finance and Ernst & Young (EY) dated 11 November 2015 (the Deed).

References in the Official Order to:

- a. "we" are deemed references to EY; and
- b. "you" or "Client" are deemed references to the Department of Communications and the Arts (DoCA)

We will provide you with a report addressing the scope items above (the "Report"), subject to the limitations outlined in this Agreement and the Deed.

Informal oral comments made in discussions with you or presentations to you about any Report will not have any greater significance than explanations or other material contained in the Report and reliance should only be placed on information and comments set out in the final Report. Our role is to provide you with advice and observations for your consideration. We will not perform any management functions or make any management decisions.

During the course of this assignment, we may provide status reports or show drafts of our Report to you (including your internal accounting teams where appropriate). This is done on the basis that they are provided to inform you of progress and significant findings identified to date, and to seek confirmation of the facts contained within it. Any draft Reports provided are subject to revision and alteration as further work is performed or further information received. No reliance should be placed on any draft document without our prior written consent. You acknowledge and agree that in the event that such a reliance letter is entered into, the limitations on our liability under the terms of this Engagement Agreement (including those set out in the attached General Terms and Conditions) will apply to the addressee of this Engagement Agreement and all parties entering into the reliance letter.

As the engagement progresses, you may decide that you wish to vary the scope of work. We will discuss such matters with you and any changes to the scope of work will be agreed between us in writing. Should you wish to discuss this additional scope with you, we would be happy to provide a scope and fee quote at that time.

2. Ordered Services

The results of our work will be used by DoCA solely for the purpose of assisting DoCA to implement appropriate controls with respect to its interest in nbn in

order to manage risks and compliance with the required Australian Accounting Standards and will not be provided to any unrelated third parties.

Our scope of work is to prepare a gap analysis of the current risk management framework against our observations of general industry practices associated with a financial institution. Our report will provide recommendations and an implementation roadmap to support closure of the identified gaps. We will also prepare a gap analysis of the governance framework in place to achieve compliance with respective accounting standards. Both of these will be undertaken with respect to DoCA's interest in nbn to inform development of appropriate controls to manage risks, and compliance with the required Australian Accounting Standards in order to assist DoCA in satisfying audit expectations.

In assessing the risk management and accounting frameworks we will consider (at a minimum) the following items:

- a. the current approach to identification of key strategic and operational risks, and processes to monitor these risks;


