### Written agreement for payment of RAV charge after vehicle entered on RAV

Under section 254 of the *Road Vehicle Standards Rules 2019* (the Rules), the holder of a road vehicle type approval under which a vehicle is entered on the Register of Approved Vehicles (RAV) is liable to pay the RAV entry charge for each vehicle entered on the RAV. The charge is due and payable as specified in the invoice issued to the holder of the approval.

Although, ordinarily a vehicle will not be entered on the RAV before the charge is paid, subparagraph 12A(1)(a)(iii) of the Rules sets out the holder of a road vehicle type approval may enter into a written agreement with the Secretary of the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications (the department), on behalf of the Commonwealth, that the invoice may be issued after the vehicle is entered on the RAV.

Accordingly, I / I on behalf of the road vehicle type approval holder listed below, seek the agreement of the Secretary to issue an invoice for RAV entry charges after the vehicle(s) is/are entered on the RAV, and acknowledge:

- if payment is not made with the correct amount by the date specified in the invoice issued to the holder of the approval, or
- if payment is made by EFT and the payment reference number specified on the invoice is not included as the reference number, this agreement may be suspended or terminated in writing and
- the holder of the approval may also suspend or terminate this agreement on request by writing to the Secretary using the online [enquiry form](#).
