CHANGES TO RUNWAY NOTIFICATIONS

TAILWIND SAFETY CASE

GOAL


Obtain approval for an 18 month trial of increased tailwind allowances between 10pm and 6am

AMBITION

Gather sufficient data to support an application for a permanent increase in allowable tailwinds

Process

- Development of a safety case for CASA approval to permit a time limited trial of increased tailwinds at BNE
- Data from the previous submissions will be supplemented with a new concept of operations
- Collaborative approach with Airservices and all affected airlines
- Data gathered for the first 12 months will be used to support an application for continued usage of the procedure
- Plan Safe, an Australian based safety consultancy, have been appointed to lead the development.
