## Communications Legislation Amendment (Combatting Misinformation and Disinformation) Bill 2023

I understand that ACMA already has powers in relation to media, however, this new bill will affect everyone's freedom to look at different media that they feel will give them the information they require to make their own decisions. We have seen over the past 3 years that misinformation has been given out by mainstream media, so will they have the same restrictions under this new bill and if not why not and again who will monitor this?

In short, your new bill will affect everyone's right to free speech and as politicians I request that you support and represent the public who after all elected you. Australia is a democratic country and should continue to uphold the rights of its citizens.

I personally cannot support this bill and would strongly urge you to reconsider your decision to introduce The Communication Legislation Amendment (Combatting Misinformation and Disinformation) Bill 2023.
