I oppose the proposal to make the use of 'ADSB-out' mandatory for all airspace users everywhere in Australia. Many airspace users are recreational pilots of craft such as hang gliders, paragliders and microlights/ nanolights - which do not have cockpits or power supplies - and have limited space available for installation/ carriage of such devices. There would also be an additional cost and pilot workload for equipment installation, checking & monitoring and maintenance of such devices.
