I strongly disagree. Paragliders and hang gliders must be exempt from the ADS-B requirement.

- 1. Impractical & Unsafe: These are unpowered aircraft with no reliable way to power or mount an ADS-B unit. Added weight and wiring affect handling, balance, and increase landing injury risk.
- 2. Different Flight Characteristics: Freeflight aircraft are slow and limited in maneuverability. Collision avoidance responsibility should rest with powered or remotely piloted aircraft, consistent with "power gives way to sail."
- 3. Harm to Recreational Aviation: ADS-B gear adds cost, clutter, and regulation to a simple, low-risk sport. It would discourage participation and threaten the future of freeflight in Australia.

The proposed inclusion is impractical, unsafe, and disproportionate to the risk.
