I submit the following for your Aviation White Paper. has always been a quiet area and our family have been in since 1968. We have been dealing with a changed flight path, instigated by Air Services Australia to the Hobart Airport since 2017. There was no consultation to surrounding communities on this flight path change and lengthy discussions by members of the Public have fallen on deaf ears. Air Services Australia in setting this flight path has compromised the way we live and disadvantaged our health and wellbeing. Air Services Australia undertook a Review of their flight path over our community. We continue to wait, hoping they address the REAL issues presented to them. The one element missing from most decisions made around Aviation is the communities that live underneath the flight paths. The closer you are to the Airports the closer planes travel overhead. It has been noted that has been getting up to 70 flights a day. On a personal note, the planes have been travelling extremely low and the noise is quite deafening. Air Services Australia's own data and from their information sessions at in 2022 agreed that Airlines changed their behaviour to utilize the shorter flight path into Hobart Airport. This changed Airline behaviour meant over 80% of flights to Hobart used this flight path. sea NOT over the land.

- We currently have issues with noise This has been tested and found to be well above acceptable Australian standards This is NOT ACCEPTABLE
- Air traffic volumes No overhead flights pre-2017, now up to 70 flights a day This is NOT ACCEPTABLE
- Jet fuel exhaust particles pollution This is NOT ACCEPTABLE

and surrounding areas depend exclusively on clean tank water to maintain good health and wellbeing.
