Notification for Public Consultation required under the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act)

The Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications, Sport and the Arts (the department), under sections 341s and 342s of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act), has prepared a draft Heritage Management Plan for Cascade Reserve, Norfolk Island.

Under the paragraph 10.03C, Section 341S of the EPBC Act, the department welcomes comments on the draft Heritage Management Plan from members of the public, First Nations people with rights and interests in the place, key stakeholders, and community groups by close of business 24 September 2026 (20 days after which the last notice is published).
