Checklist for a concessional RAV entry approval application for a personal effects vehicle

	Identify who would be the approval holder responsible for meeting all the approval conditions. For a personal effects vehicle the applicant must be the individual owner.
	Provide documents indicating your entitlement to live in Australia indefinitely, for example, an Australian passport or information about relevant visas you may hold.
Vehi	cle details
	Provide details of the vehicle's make, model, year of manufacture, seating capacity, motive power (petrol, diese electric battery) and type (passenger vehicle, motorcycle, van).
	Provide the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or chassis number.
	Provide proof you own the vehicle and have done so for at least 12 months, such as a purchase invoice or registration certificate.
	Provide proof you became the owner while living overseas.
	Provide evidence showing that you have used the vehicle regularly on a public road outside Australia where you have been living permanently.

- front of the vehicle
- rear of the vehicle
- sides (left and right) of the vehicle

Provide photos of the vehicle, including:

- the VIN and compliance/manufacturer's plate
- odometer
- engine.

- resignation acceptance letter from overseas employer
- cancellation of utilities services overseas
- sale/cancellation of overseas property
- shipment of your household goods to Australia. (for example, copies of shipping documents).

Provide evidence of 12-months continuous residency in the country where the vehicle was purchased, before the date you arrived in Australia. This could include:

- rental receipts/purchase documents
- employment records
- utilities statements

Provide details of when you arrived/intend to arrive in Australia.

Provide details of any previous personal effects approval granted under the RVS or the corresponding approval under the former *Motor Vehicle Standards Act 1989*.

IMPORTANT: Please do not provide your tax file number as supporting information in your application.
