The Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts (the Department) is inviting community feedback on the provision of air services to Christmas Island (CI) and the Cocos (Keeling) Islands (CKI) through the IOT Air Services Survey.

The Australian Government is required to re-tender for the provision of IOT air services, as Virgin Australia's current contract reaches the end of its term (expiring in late 2025).

While the Department must follow Commonwealth procurement rules when selecting the next IOT air services provider, results from the survey will support this procurement by providing valuable information about the needs and preferences of IOT residents, businesses and travellers in general.

The survey is broad-ranging, covering issues such as preferred flight days, ticketing and baggage, flight routing, and overall service preferences for both passenger and freight flights. All survey responses will be treated confidentially.

All IOT residents, businesses and other stakeholders are urged to actively engage in the survey process, as your feedback will be used to help shape future delivery of IOT air services.
