Topic: 2024-25 charges for Vehicle Examination Fees for the Indian Ocean Territories

An updated schedule of vehicle examination fees has been introduced in the Indian Ocean Territories (IOT) of Christmas Island and the Cocos (Keeling) Islands from 1 July 2024.

IOT vehicle examination fees are aligned with the Kimberley region of Western Australia, and are updated annually.

The following fee amendments are applied to vehicle examination fees in 2024-25:

Item 1	Heavy vehicle	(a) first examination—increases from \$262.70 to \$268.70;
		(b) subsequent examination— increases from \$152.55 to \$154.35
