I want to get there and back quickly but the nearest bus stops do not have a solid concrete foundation and/or provide insufficient kerbing. The last time I used the stop, my wheels got bogged in the dirt and due to low ground, the bus ramp was steep. I then had to make the driver move to solid pavement. I now rarely visit the nearby shopping centre as it is a hassle getting there and back safely.
