
Application Process - controlled activities on terrain that intrudes into a Secondary Surface

Section 7 - Controlled activities on terrain that intrudes into secondary airspace

This section applies in relation to a controlled activity if:


- the terrain on which the activity is carried out intrudes into a secondary surface; and
- the activity is not carried out in relation to primary airspace; and
- if the activity is an activity referred to in paragraph 182(1)(a), (b) or (c) of the Act—the height of the building, structure or thing referred to in that paragraph is no more than 30 metres above ground level.

Application Process – Secondary Surfaces





Application Process – Sensitive Controlled Activities

Stage 1 – Permission to apply to carry out sensitive controlled activities

A person must not apply under section 12 for approval to carry out a sensitive controlled activity (section 6) unless the person has first been given permission under section 13.
