Decision made under the Freedom of Information Act 1982 – Release in full

I refer to your request to the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications (**the Department**) received on 12 September 2021 for access to documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (**the FOI Act**). You requested the following documents:

"Full list of expenditures by the Australian Government for the Norfolk Island Central School (NICS) from 1 January 2015 to 12 September 2021 and including who was contracted and the amount allocated."

Authority

I am an officer authorised by the Secretary to make decisions about access to documents in the possession of the Department in accordance with subsection 23(1) of the FOI Act.

Decision

I have made a decision to release relevant information the Department holds in full.

Documents subject to this request

The Department does not hold a specific document that is relevant to your request, however the information outlined below provides the information you are seeking.

- Since 2016, as part of the Heads of Agreement between the Commonwealth and State of NSW (the Agreement), the NSW Government delivers health and education services to Norfolk Island, and provides limited local government support, funded by the Australian Government through the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications (the Department).
- The NSW Department of Education receives funding as part of the supporting School Services Schedule, which sits under the Agreement, to provide education services to Norfolk Island Central School (NICS). This includes funding for the management and administration of the school, provision of teacher staffing and the delivery of the NSW curriculum and learning programs.
- Funding provided by the Department to the NSW Department of Education for the cost of running NICS and related services is below:
 - \$4,613,423.00 in FY 2016/17;
 - \$6,811,586.00 in FY 2017/18;
 - \$6,668,000.02 in FY 2018/19;
 - \$7,843,610.68 in FY 2019/20;

- \$8,613,634.24 in FY 2020/21; and
- As at 12 September 2021, Q1 has not been goods receipted.
- Further to this funding, the Department provides direct funding to NICS for capital upgrades and the provision of (non-teaching) ancillary staff on an as needed basis. Funding details are as below.

Capital Works

The capital works projects include upgrades to school buildings, new classroom furniture, improved water quality, replacement of the ICT infrastructure and upgrades to the plumbing and electrical systems.
