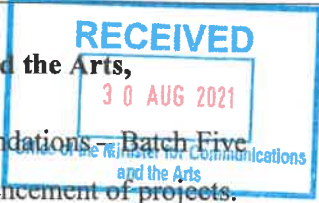



Purpose:

- Your approval is sought under section 71 of the *Public Governance, Performance and Accountability Act 2013* (PGPA Act) to commit \$20,339,319 million for 63 recommended projects submitted to the RISE Fund (the Fund) at Attachment A.
- A copy of the RISE Fund guidelines (the guidelines), and your responsibilities under the PGPA Act and the Commonwealth Financial Management Framework are outlined at Attachment C and D respectively.

Key Issues:

- Due to the high volume of applications submitted to Batch Four of the RISE Fund, you agreed that applications with projects starting before 1 October 2021 be prioritised for assessment as Batch Four, and applications with projects starting after 1 October 2021 be assessed as Batch Five. All applications to Batches Four and Five were required to be submitted by 20 June 2021.
- In considering recommendations to Batch Four, you agreed that 44 projects that met the objectives of the program to a moderate degree, and were in excess of your preference to commit around \$40 million, be considered as part of Batch Five. As a result, two applications from the 44 are recommended for funding in Batch Five
- A total of 467 applications were considered in Batch Five, with 11 of these deemed ineligible against the guidelines. Each application was assessed in accordance with the guidelines by at least two departmental assessors with advice provided by the Australia Council and the Creative Economy Taskforce. § 22

Additional Information:

Background

The Fund is a part of the Government's \$250 million Creative Economy Support Package. The purpose of the Fund is to support the arts and entertainment sector to reactivate by funding the presentation of cultural and creative activities and events disrupted by the COVID-19 restrictions. The primary objectives of the Fund are to provide increased employment opportunities and economic activity, build the long-term sustainability of cultural and creative organisations and provide cultural and creative experiences to audiences across Australia. Activities funded to date have strongly met these objectives.

Organisations eligible to apply are those with the primary purpose of delivering arts and entertainment activities that demonstrate that in the absence of funding, the activity would be substantially less likely to proceed as a consequence of COVID-19. Under the current guidelines, grants usually range from between \$25,000 and \$2 million, depending on the scope of the activity. Smaller or larger requests are able to be considered.

There are no funding rounds, with applications batched for assessment in line with publicly stated timeframes.

Batch five assessments

All Batch Five applications underwent an eligibility check and 11 applications, which did not meet the eligibility criteria, were deemed ineligible by the department and did not proceed to assessment. These applicants have been notified. Of the 456 eligible applications, one applicant is from your electorate of Bradfield and is not recommended for funding.

Eligible applications were assessed by at least two department assessors, against the three program-specific criteria outlined in section 6 of the Fund guidelines:

1. the degree to which the grant will contribute to achieving the objectives and outcomes of the program;
2. the demonstrated expertise of and capacity of the organisation to undertake the grant activity including in a COVID-safe manner; and
3. the demonstrated financial viability of the grant activity.

The RISE Fund guidelines state that during the assessment process, the department may seek advice and input from the Australia Council, the Creative Economy Taskforce and relevant state and territory government agencies.

The department consulted with the Australia Council on these projects. Feedback from Council considered the nature of the application, size of the funding request and relevant background information, including funding history and the capacity of an organisation.

Partial funding

The Fund guidelines allow for partial or full funding to be offered to applicants. Given the competitive nature of the program and the size of applicant requests, the department recommends partial funding for eight recommended projects.

Partial funding is recommended where the total proposed expenditure does not align with program objectives, the capacity of an organisation to implement a project of such scale, or to achieve overall value for money. In most cases, the Fund will contribute to wages, the costs associated with COVID-safe infrastructure, or the first year of a two year project. It is anticipated that Commonwealth funding will leverage funding from other sources for the second year.

Partial funding also allows a higher number of grants to be awarded with a greater distribution of projects.

Recommendations

The department recommends 63 recommended projects be supported. These projects are anticipated to create over 22,756 jobs and reach over 560 locations, including 316 locations in regional and remote Australia. These projects will have significant benefits for the live music industry and will have strong economic flow on effects to allied sectors.

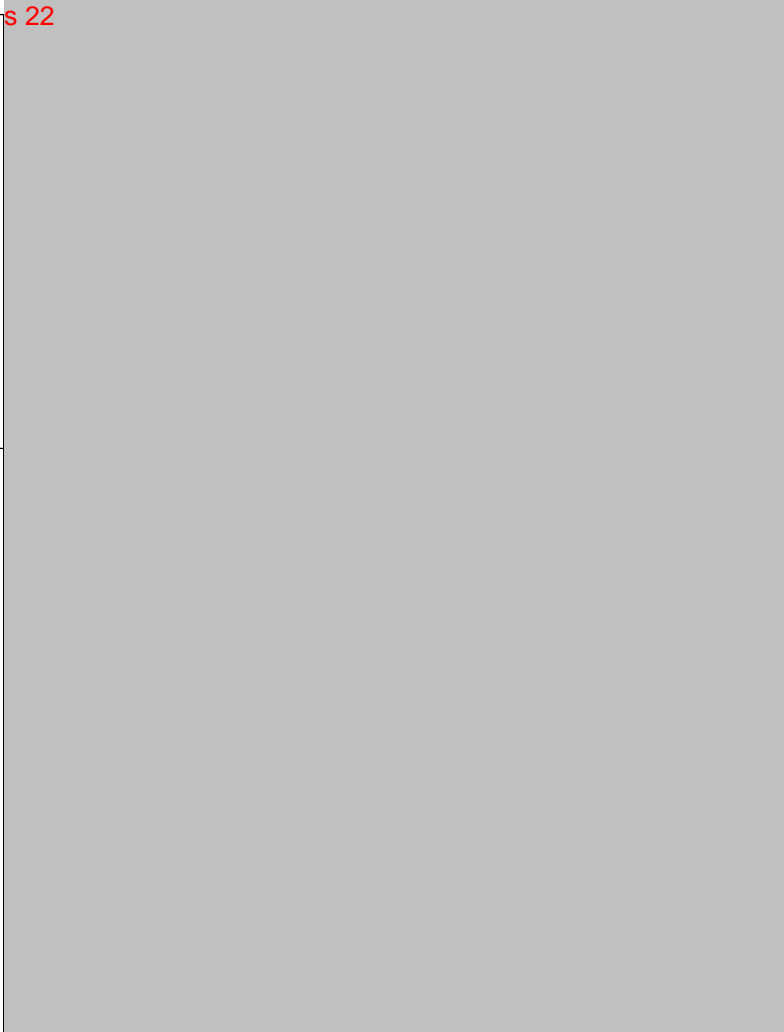

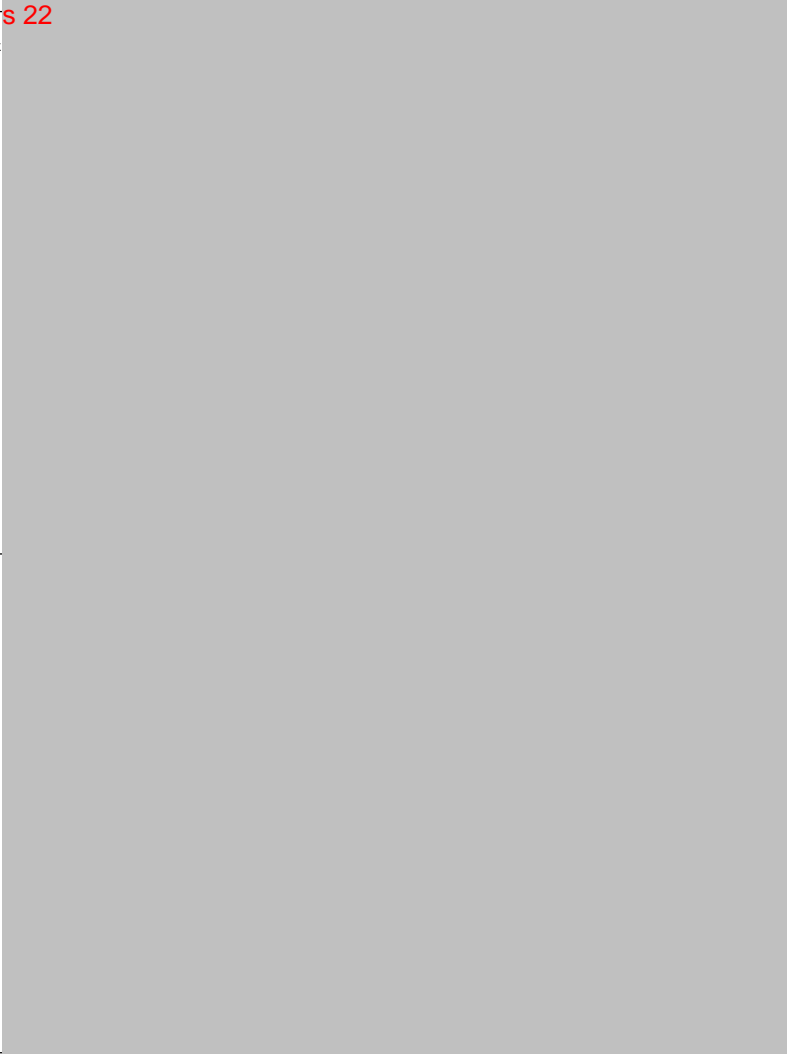
