Interchange work to ease congestion

The State Transport Minister says upgrades to the Verdun and Mt Barker interchanges will result in a reduction of almost 1000 vehicles each day on the Hahndorf Main Street.

Minister Tom Koutsantonis said modelling by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (DIT) showed a total traffic reduction of 990 vehicles a day for the entire Main Street under the \$250m Hahndorf Township Improvements and Access Project.

However a majority of the vehicles to be diverted are anticipated to be light vehicles, not heavy vehicles, which residents have been most vocal about.

It comes after some residents criticised the Government's decision to abandon four options previously proposed by DIT to alleviate congestion of the main street.

The Government has instead chosen to upgrade the Verdun and Mt Barker interchanges, revitalise the Hahndorf Main Street and develop a multipurpose car park facility at Verdun.

DIT modelling predicts there will be 880 fewer light vehicles and cars per day, and 110 fewer trucks, buses and heavy vehicles per day under the upgrades.

This includes light traffic being reduced by 8% north and 11% south of Pine Avenue, and light through-traffic (any vehicles travelling through Hahndorf Main Street to reach other destinations, including the freeway) reduced by 22%north and 38% south of Pine Avenue.

The modelling also predicts that heavy traffic will be reduced by 20% north and 29% south of Pine Avenue, and heavy through-traffic will be reduced by 37% north and 55% south of Pine Avenue.

Mr Koutsantonis said traffic modelling had been used to assess current and projected trips along the Hahndorf Main Street based on the proposed upgrades.

"We do real-time monitoring ... we check traffic markers to try and identify the type of vehicles that are using these roads and where they're going," he said.

"Our current estimate is nearly 1000 vehicles a day off Hahndorf. "Of course that's a minimum, not a

maximum. It could be more."

While a bypass at Hahndorf was left out of the final design for the Hahndorf township upgrade, Mr Koutsantonis State Transport Minister Tom Koutsantonis said traffic modelling had been used

said he would be willing to consider a bypass in the future.

The bypass hasn't been scrapped, what's happened is we feel the best outcome for this project is not to do this (for now) and do more work on Verdun and Mt Barker because of the negative impacts on (Paechtown)," he said. "The Verdun and Mt Barker

interchanges are a win for everyone."

Mr Koutsantonis met with Hahndorf residents on Friday to listen to their concerns, and said their feedback would be factored into the project.
