





Just hoping to get your advice on something. In addition to general community cargo, there's obviously a backlog and ongoing demand for Commonwealth and Council freight as well. Off the top of my head, we have project gear to get to island, Parks have road works, Australia Post are keen for space, and I know Council has need for equipment as well. If I did a whip-around, I'd probably find more.

Pending the barge going forward, would you anticipate that we'd need to contract in a Government allocation on the barge, or do you think there'd be enough space that we could start moving some of the priority equipment through without that security? Community need is obviously the priority, but delayed project freight has difficult flow-ons, so we'd like some capacity to feed it through steadily if possible. This doesn't need to be all at once – we can work collectively to prioritise within limited space – as long as you're able to guarantee some capacity throughout the voyages.



# **Progressing shipping solutions for Norfolk Island**

The Australian Government is subsidising monthly barges from Brisbane to Norfolk Island over the peak tourist period, relieving critical freight pressures ahead of community consultations on longer-term shipping solutions.

Starting in November, there will be four subsidised barge trips run by NPDL through to February 2023. These will help address the immediate shortages you are experiencing and support businesses and the community through summer and high visitor numbers.

Government financial support for the barges is the first in a series of measures to stabilise sea freight in the short-term. Further information on other initiatives under development will come in the weeks ahead as discussions with stakeholders and shipping providers progress.

In the meantime, we will continue to subsidise air freight flights to help address critical shortfalls. The barge service is separate to any voyages by the Southern Tiare.

As I announced last week, I will return to Norfolk Island on 14 November 2022 to lead an open community forum on long-term shipping solutions.

Ahead of the forum, my Department will shortly open a Have Your Say written submission process to inform the community forum, where we will have a broad discussion on the future of your shipping.

Norfolk Island service is a sea barge discharge operation whereby cargo is lifted off vessel to lighters at sea. These lighters can only accept LCL cargo therefore GP's are not normally serviceable. There has been a recent disruption in this service as new lighters were required and have only just now come into service. Due to this we are currently investigating options to get this service back operational with a new barge service.

I should be able to provide some more information on this and options likely next week. Apologies for the delay in getting back to you.
