Please see the attached cleared metrics document for the evaluation. You'll notice we've added an additional metric drawn from a one-off compliance pulse survey. While this survey won't be repeated, we thought the statistic may be helpful given the other metrics are based on baseline data and therefore unlikely to be that useful.

*Proportion of parents reporting that their child (aged 8–15 years) had their own social media account pre- and post-implementation of the SMMA:*

- Pre-implementation: 49.7%
- Post-implementation: 31.3%

This metric will also be included in the compliance report, so it will be public by the time the meeting occurs.

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# Evaluation of the SMMA

## Metrics from the baseline survey

Brief note to let you know we met with the regulatory team at eSafety today to discuss the upcoming public compliance update for SMMA.

- eSafety has a number of information gathering processes in the field, including seeking updated data (to update the 4.7 million figure) and also in relation to the systems and processes platforms have in place (as it relates to “reasonable steps”).
- They will also draw on information from their investigations branch, their parent pulse survey to provide an update on implementation of SMMA.
- They will confirm that “active regulatory investigations” are under way but will flag some serious concerns with compliance by platforms (not to be named).
- They may use some case studies (again, not naming platforms). They will confirm they will continue to work with platforms.
- eSafety Commissioner will also note she has written to platforms assessed as in-scope that they continue to be (in light of the new Rule).

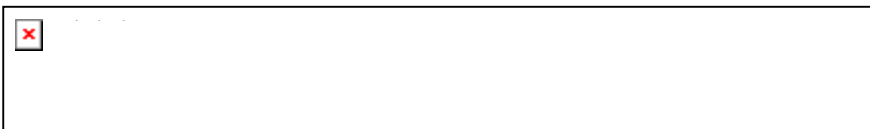

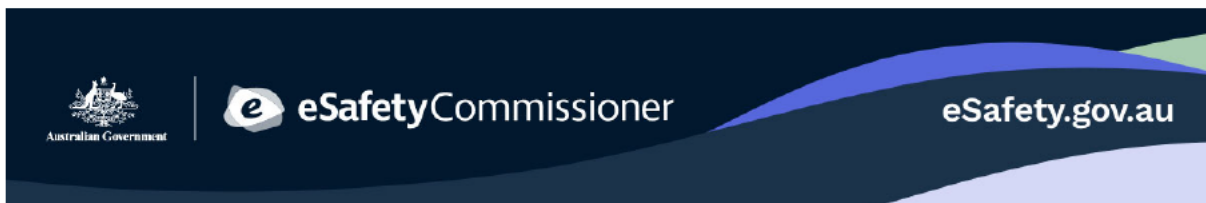
