- 3. In the 2022-23 October Budget the Government also agreed to allocate \$1 billion in administered funding to PCIP. This is also a closed non-competitive program to deliver election commitments and eligible projects committed by the previous Government's Community Development Grants Programme as part of their 2022 PEFO. The program includes commitments of \$5 million or more, as well as a small number of lower value commitments nominated by you.
- 4. For both programs, the allocation of funding was determined with reference to lists of projects formulated in discussion with the Department of Finance and your office.
