

1. The following table provides detail of the total purchases, by eligible connectivity solution categories and by Approved Supplier under Round 2 of the On Farm Connectivity Program.

a. Eligible connectivity solution categories are defined by the On Farm Connectivity Program Round 2 Grant Opportunity Guidelines (Appendix B p.44-45) and comprise of: Connectivity equipment, Environmental monitoring, Farm management, Remote automation and control and Low Power Wide Area Networks (LPWAN). These categories have been shaded in yellow in the below table.

b. There are also other eligible expenditure items, such as: delivery and installation costs, subscriptions and cost of training. These categories have been shaded in green in the below table.

2. '**Total of purchases under the Program**' represents the total sales made for products that recieved rebates under the Program - representing a total of \$35.165 million of equipment purchases received rebates under the Program. Up to 50% of the purchase price was available to be rebated (in accordance with the Grant Opportunity Guidelines) and in many cases, purchases exceeded \$60,000 and so the maximum rebate amount of \$30,000 represented less than 50% of the purchase price. In these cases, the data to apportion the maximum rebate amount of \$30,000 across eligible equipment categories was not collected and so data on total purchases, which were collected have been provided.

3. There were 364 Approved Suppliers under Round 2 of the On Farm Connectivity Program, and the complete list can be found at On Farm Connectivity Program Round 2 Grant Opportunity Guidelines (Appendix A p.20-43). Of these 364 Approved Suppliers, 122 Approved Suppliers successfully claimed for at least 1 rebate; the other 242 Approved Suppliers did not receive a rebate. Accordingly, the table below comprises of the 122 Approved Suppliers who received at least 1 rebate.
