I know you would be as concerned as I am at hearing these stories. Driving students deserve to feel safe whilst learning to drive. Driving instructors, just like teachers and those in positions of responsibility in our society, have a duty to ensure these environments are safe. Allegations of inappropriate behaviour by driving instructors should be taken seriously and handled appropriately.

I recognise that you have existing mechanisms in place regarding the certification and complaints handling for driving instructors. I would appreciate your advice on any further measures you may be able to put in place, in light of these recent reports.

The Albanese Government is committed to preventing sexual harassment and assault by creating safer, respectful and more equitable society and workplaces. We continue to work closely with state and territory counterparts on delivering this, and I thank you for all your work.

I look forward to your response on this matter. I have copied this letter to Senator the Hon. Katy Gallagher, the Minister for Women and the Hon Tanya Plibersek MP, the Minister for Social Services.
