



How to withdraw, amend and resubmit or delete an application in ROVER

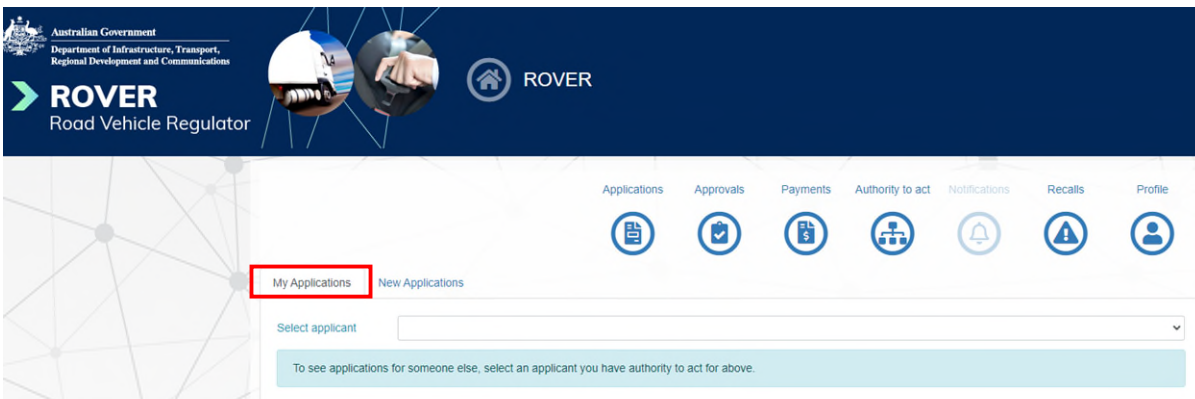
You can withdraw an application after it has been submitted through ROVER even after you have paid the submission fee. Once you have withdrawn an application you can amend and resubmit it, or delete it.

This user guide shows you the steps to follow in ROVER to withdraw an application and to amend and resubmit it, or delete it.

Note: Applications for an advisory notice that a thing is not a road vehicle cannot be withdrawn.

How to withdraw and amend an application

Step 1. Once you sign in to [ROVER](#), click the **My Applications** tab on the homepage.

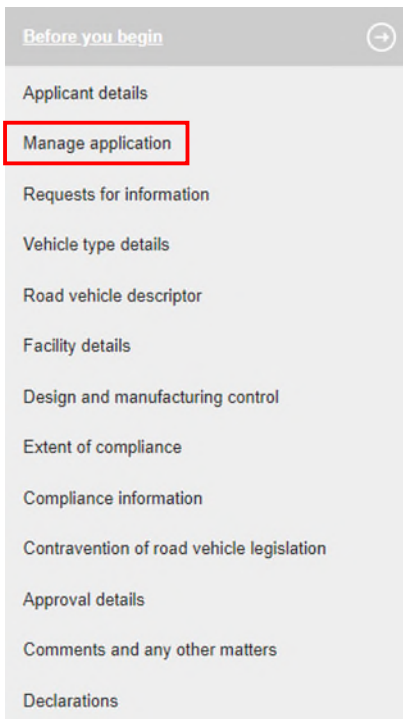


Step 2. Open the application you want to withdraw by clicking the application number in the **Submitted Applications** table.

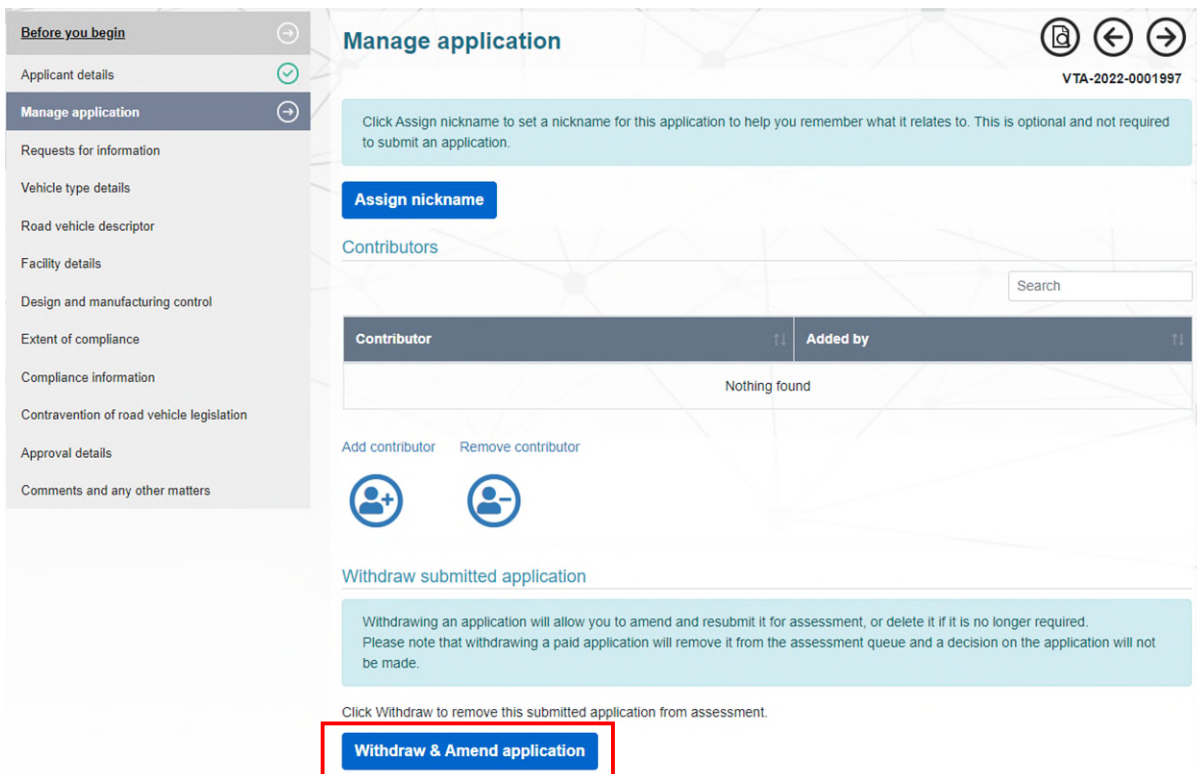

Step 3. Select **Manage application** from the menu on the left-hand side of the screen.



Step 4. Click on the **Withdraw & Amend application** button at the bottom of the page.



Step 5. The **Withdraw** application screen will open. Choose **Yes** then click the **Confirm** button.

Withdrawing an application will allow you to amend and resubmit it for assessment, or delete it if it is no longer required. Please note that withdrawing a paid application will remove it from the assessment queue and a decision on the application will not be made.

How to amend and resubmit a withdrawn application

You can now click on the application number to open your application, make your amendments and resubmit following the same process you used for the original application.

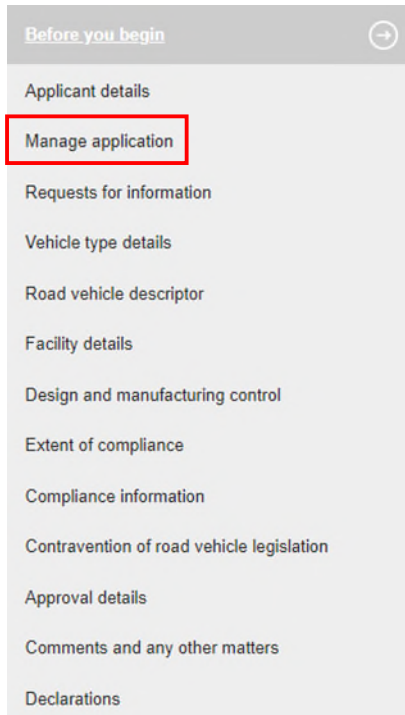

How to delete a withdrawn application

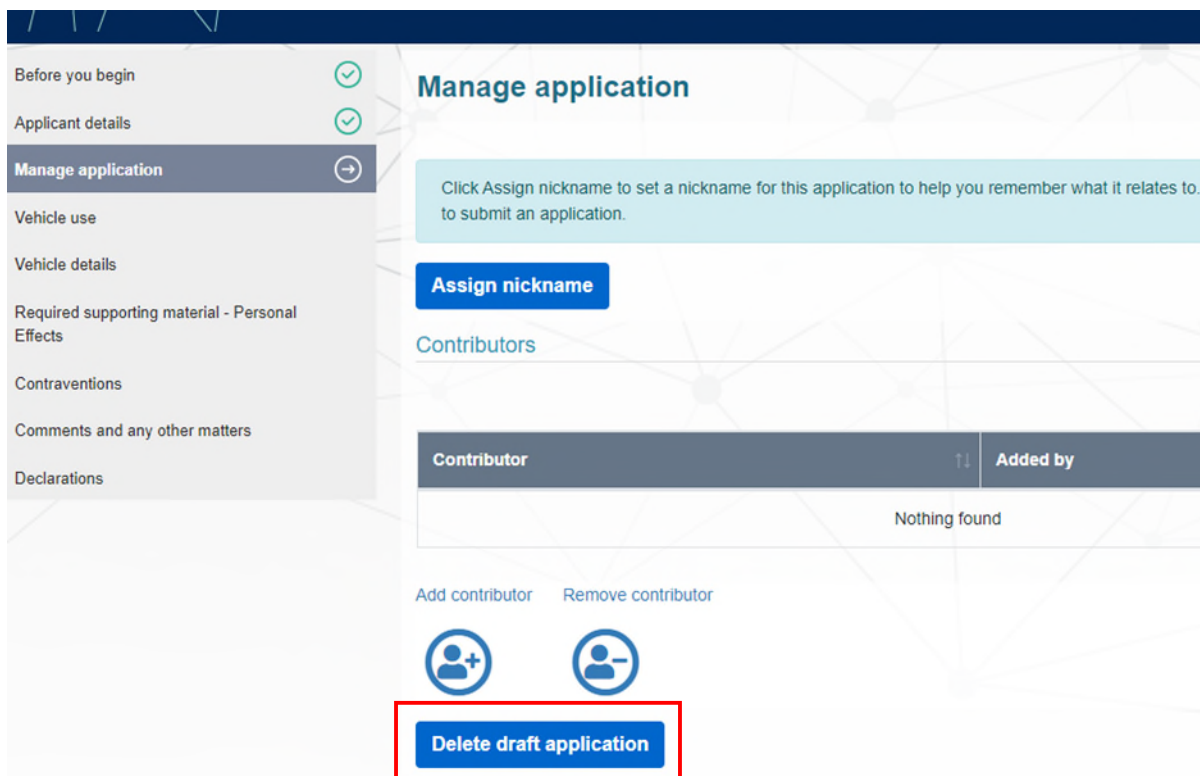
If you no longer want to proceed with your application you can delete it.

Step 1. Open the application you want to delete, then select **Manage application** from the menu on the left-hand side of the screen.

Note: Your application must be in **Draft** status if you want to delete it.



Step 2. Click on the **Delete draft application** button.




Step 3. The **Delete draft application** page will appear and you can select **Yes** to delete the application.

Once an application has been submitted and paid, then withdrawn and deleted, it will no longer appear in ROVER.

However, the receipt of payment for the withdrawn and deleted application will remain in the past payments page in the payments section of your ROVER account.

Note: Once you click on **Confirm** the draft application will be permanently deleted.
