I am writing to let you know about a WHS incident that occurred at Alinga St on Friday last week that I have just been advised of.

Two pieces of concrete fell from the ceiling cavity of Level 1 onto a ceiling tile. Fortunately the ceiling tile and concrete didn't crash through on the people sitting below.

The dimensions of the pieces are:

Piece 1 – 26cm x 15cm – 0.66kg

Piece 2 – 22cm x 40cm – 1.48kg

A photo is attached.

The building manager had people attend on Saturday 12 July and they did not identify any further concrete damage. However, they are arranging a surveyor to come out to further inspect the building. This has not been scheduled yet.

We are meeting with Property and CBRE again tomorrow morning. I will attend this meeting. We are giving consideration to whether we need to temporarily relocate people in that work area. If we propose to proceed with this, we will develop a plan in quick time about how we will communicate this and work with you before taking any steps.

I am conscious that without the surveyor undertaking an inspection, we don't know the extent of the problem. I will press for CBRE to have the surveyor attend tomorrow given the WHS risk involved.

I'll keep you posted after tomorrow's meeting.

The area near workstation A.1.249 on Level 1 will remain cordoned off until we have certainty from the structural engineer there is no further danger. Further to my call earlier this morning, regarding a report about 'falling pebble sounds' in the ceiling of Alinga Level 1 East, I have taken the following action:

- I met with Lachlan Wood, AS Vic, Tas, SA Infrastructure Investment onsite. We agreed to move 24 staff from the southern side of Level 1 East, Alinga St building, which also includes staff from Bill Brummett's branch, Qld Infrastructure Investment and 2032 Qld Games. Staff have been provided the flexible work space on Ground Floor Alinga St, which has 16 work stations. Lachlan has discussed with Bill and has confirmed staff will share that space; and that they also have space for use in other parts of Level 1 Alinga;
- I've spoken to the Evolve Building Manager, sate and asked that he contact CBRE, requesting they provide an engineer to inspect the site again today (as opposed to Friday, as planned). He explained that both he and plumbers were on the balcony outside the affected area, and gravel and moss had been swept down PVC pipes. He explained that this created the 'pebble falling' sounds. Regardless of this, I've requested follow up inspection from the CBRE engaged engineer today, to provide us with assurance of immediate safety for staff in the building;
- I've requested safe and our Property Team to extend the cordoned off the area from the Western corner of the area, right down the Southern wall, to the Eastern wall of the building, incorporating the work stations of those staff referred to above:
- I've requested our Property team to prepare an email to the two affected Branches Qld Infrastructure Investment and 2032 Qld Games; and Vic, Tas, SA Infrastructure Investment, for communication today to reassure staff we're addressing the potential issues immediately; and
- I've spoken with Andrew Bourne and provided a brief update to him on the situation.

I will provide you with a further update once we've received information from the engineers/building manager.

Dear colleagues

We're writing to provide an update regarding the recent noise reported near workstation A.1.249 on Level 1 (Alinga) this morning, Wednesday 23 July.

As you know, following the incident on 11 July, the area has been cordoned off as a precation while investigations and assessments continue. This morning, some staff nearby heard what sounded like pebbles falling above the ceiling, which raised concerns. No staff were in the affected zone at the time of the report.

Following an investigation by our onsite Facilities Manager, we can confirm the noise was the result of maintenance work on Level 2. Plumbers were attending the outdoor balcony directly above to inspect for possible water leaks. During this work, moss was cleared from a blocked sump, and some gravel travelled down a connected PVC pipe.

This sound is consistent with what was heard on Level 1. The plumbers and Facilities Manager inspected the ceiling area at A.1.249 shortly after and confirmed there was **no new debris** and the ceiling tiles were unaffected.

While this was not related to any further ceiling damage, the area remains cordoned off as a precaution until we receive final advice from the structural engineer.

At this stage, please note the following:

- The recent noise was linked to maintenance activity above the area on Level 2, not falling debris.
- The cordoned-off section on Level 1 remains in place.
- Staff in the affected area should continue to work from other available spaces or from home.
- There is no change to current safety advice or working arrangements.







Dear Colleagues,

As you know a few weeks ago, we discovered some concrete spalling in the ceiling space on level 1 of Alinga Street. The concrete spalling was on the underside of the slab above and some concrete had fallen onto the ceiling tiles, noting that it wasn't large enough or heavy enough to fall through the ceiling tiles, we still took precautionary measures to close off the space underneath the affected area to ensure staff safety. Concrete spalling is a process where the surface of concrete deteriorates, leading to cracking, flaking, and crumbling and is often caused by a combination of factors like moisture, freeze-thaw cycles, and corrosion of the steel reinforcement within the concrete.

The landlord conducted an extensive review of all ceiling spaces throughout the building, during which they discovered another 2 small sections of concrete spalling on levels 5 and 6. As with Level 1, precautionary measures were taken to immediately cordon off both these areas with hazard tape, signage and staff in the immediate areas were advised of the issue.

The landlord has advised that they are undertaking rectification works starting this afternoon, Thursday 14 August and continuing on Friday 15 August 2025. The works are intended to ensure the affected areas are safe and any potential concrete debris is contained above ceiling level.

Please note disruptive and/or noisy works will commence as of 5:30pm today, Thursday 14 August 2025.

FYI Looking at the below schedule of works: Thurs Afternoon - Site establishment consists of laying plastic over the affected desks and removal of roof tiles so this will cause a little disruption to staff. The noisy works will commence after 5:30pm tomorrow and go through the night.

Then on Friday it will only be the engineers assessing the catchment solution after completion of works so minimal disruption to staff.

The fire isolations will run throughout to avoid any alarms being triggered.

As a precautionary measure we may want to reinstate all cordoned off areas following the completion of the works until such time as we receive written confirmation from the engineers that the area is now safe to use. Just a thought.

As you know a few weeks ago, we discovered some concrete spalling in the ceiling space on level 1 of Alinga Street. The concrete spalling was on the underside of the slab above and some concrete had fallen onto the ceiling tiles, noting that it wasn't large enough or heavy enough to fall through the ceiling tiles, we still took precautionary

measures to close off the space underneath the affected area to ensure staff safety. Concrete spalling is a process where the surface of concrete deteriorates, leading to cracking, flaking, and crumbling and is often caused by a combination of factors like moisture, freeze-thaw cycles, and corrosion of the steel reinforcement within the concrete.

The landlord conducted an extensive review of all ceiling spaces throughout the building, during which they discovered another 2 small sections of concrete spalling on levels 5 and 6. As with Level 1, precautionary measures were taken to immediately cordon off both these areas with hazard tape, signage and staff in the immediate areas were advised of the issue.

The landlord has advised that they are undertaking rectification works starting this afternoon, Thursday 14 August and continuing on Friday 15 August 2025. The works are intended to ensure the affected areas are safe and any potential concrete debris is contained above ceiling level.
