Dear Minister Wells,

Honouring Labor's \$1.8m for Wilson Storage Trevor Barker Oval, Sandringham

I write to seek the re-elected Albanese government honour its election commitment to provide \$1.8 million for upgrades to women's change rooms at Wilson Storage Trevor Barker Oval.

As you know, in the October 2022 Federal Budget the Albanese Labor government stripped \$100 million in infrastructure funding from the City of Bayside and Glen Eira. This has had a disastrous impact on the Goldstein electorate, and undermined vital infrastructure upgrades the community desperately needs, and has had a flow on effect of putting pressure on funding for local women's sporting facility upgrades.

As you know, at the 2022 and 2025 Federal election the Coalition made election commitments to deliver upgrades at Wilson Storage Trevor Barker Oval. This funding is vital for upgrades to women's change rooms to support women's AFL, and to ensure they have the same quality change rooms as men.


After the Coalition made its commitment, Labor made a commitment of \$1.8 million to upgrade women's change rooms at Wilson Storage Trevor Barker Oval. I therefore request the commitment be honoured and the funding be provided.

The total project cost is estimated at \$4 million, and this federal contribution would unlock co-funding from other stakeholders, including the AFL, Bayside City Council, and community partners. This project will: -

- Construct new, fit-for-purpose female-friendly change rooms in both the North and South Pavilions.
- Enable increased participation by women and girls in local sport—particularly in junior football programs.
- Support Sandringham Zebras (VFL) and multiple local sporting clubs who currently operate out of outdated and facilities.
- Strengthen the delivery of inclusive sport in a growing metropolitan region.

To ensure the dignity of young women who play footy and now requires urgent delivery.
