selectability is a not-for-profit charity committed to improving wellbeing and contributing to suicide prevention across regional Queensland.

selectability is one of regional Queensland's largest providers of NDIS psychosocial supports, and we work with the state and federal governments to deliver residential aged care, child safety, mental wellbeing, suicide prevention, and carer programs. We also own and operate selectability Training (RTO 0281). Recently selectability took on responsibility for three small first nations residential aged care homes in the Lower Gulf. We have a strategic direction of becoming an accredited Community Housing provider.

selectability has only in the last 2 mths started to give serious consideration to NAIF as a potential funding source for future infrastructure developments. NAIF CEO Craig Doyle has been amazing working with us on how this could be achieved. Really the difficulty for selectability is that we would initially be seeking funding of less than \$10m which is lower than NAIFs current guidelines.
