Phase 2 of the National Heavy Vehicle Charging Trials is testing a Manual recording option for road user charging, Hubodometers, and a “pre-paid” mock permit system for the purchase of kms. Your first mock permit/s are in this pack, and you can easily recharge any time online using the QR code.

Your business name, Registration & vehicle type are recorded here on your mock permit. You will receive a mock permit for each vehicle you have enrolled in the trial.

#### KILOMETRES TRAVELLED

Each permit will record start and end kilometre readings and how many kilometres you have elected to “pre-purchase”.

The unique serial number for the Hubodometer issued for each of your vehicles will be shown here, along with the date the permit has been issued.

The charging model being tested assumes a flat rego fee per vehicle and a per km rate based on vehicle type.
