Norfolk Island Teacher Consultative Committee – Communique #4

The Committee met on Thursday 23 September to progress discussions in relation to the transition from NSW at the conclusion of the 2021 school year.

The Committee welcomed representatives from the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) to this week's meeting. NESA provided the Committee with an overview of implementation of the Australian curriculum in the NSW schooling system.

The Committee noted subject selection for secondary school students will commence in term four as per usual practice.

Queensland officials provided further details about employment arrangements for teachers in Queensland and shared a list of key Queensland policies related to schooling.

Officials from Queensland and the Commonwealth confirmed that they are continuing to work through the log of questions received from the Norfolk Island Central School community on employment arrangements, future curriculum and administrative support.

The Committee's next meeting will be held on Friday 1 October 2021.
