



PFAS Airports Investigation Program

Jandakot Airport Community Aviation Consultation Group (CACG) update

June 2026

- All fieldworks for the Jandakot Airport investigation were completed earlier this year.
- Draft versions of the Mass Flux Study and Detailed Site Investigation (DSI) reports are currently being reviewed by the department and independent auditor.
- A Human Health and Ecological Risk Assessment (HHERA) is underway. The HHERA will evaluate potential risks to human health and the environment associated with PFAS exposure.
- The Mass Flux, DSI and HHERA reports are expected to be ready for review by the Investigation Consultation Forum (ICF) in the third quarter of this year.
- The results of the HHERA will be shared with relevant WA authorities, including WA Department of Health and WA Department of Water and Environmental Regulation, to inform advice to residents. Once the HHERA is finalised, the department will contact residents again to provide the outcomes of the HHERA and outline any further advice or next steps.
- The final stage of the investigation will be the development of a PFAS Management Plan for Jandakot Airport. This plan will outline actions needed to manage any identified risks and is expected to be finalised in late 2026.
- The department will continue to provide quarterly investigation updates to the Jandakot Airport CACG until the completion of the investigation. Updates will be published on the department's Jandakot Airport web page following each meeting:
