



PFAS Airports Investigation Program

Jandakot Airport Community Aviation Consultation Group (CACG) update

March 2026

- A final groundwater monitoring event, during which water levels were recorded and samples were collected from all groundwater wells, was completed between December 2025 and January 2026. This included sampling of three recently installed deeper wells to further understand PFAS concentrations in the deeper parts of the aquifer.
- All fieldworks are now complete. Updated results letters will be provided to residents who have had recent sampling conducted at their property under the Program.
- A Human Health and Ecological Risk Assessment (HHERA) is now being conducted. The HHERA will evaluate potential risks to human health and the environment associated with PFAS exposure and guide any future remediation and mitigation strategies that may be required in the investigation area. The results of the HHERA will be shared with relevant WA authorities, including WA Health, and will be assessed to inform the need for any further advice or action. The department will contact residents in the coming months, once the HHERA is completed.
- ERM are continuing to work on the Mass Flux Study report and the Detailed Site Investigation report. These reports, along with the HHERA, are expected to be ready for review by the Investigation Consultation Forum (ICF) in late-April 2026.
- The final stage of the investigation is the development of a PFAS Management Plan, which will set out appropriate management actions to address any identified risks. The PFAS Management Plan for Jandakot Airport is expected to be complete in the third quarter of 2026.
- The department will continue to provide quarterly investigation updates to the Jandakot Airport CACG until the completion of the investigation. Updates will be published on the department's Jandakot Airport web page following each meeting:
