Draft Historic Heritage Management Plan 2025 for Christian's Minde Settlement, Jervis Bay Territory

Notification for Public Consultation required under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act)

The Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications, Sport and the Arts (the department), under 341s of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act* 1999 (the EPBC Act), has drafted a Historic Heritage Management Plan for Christian's Minde Settlement, Jervis Bay Territory, which is included in the <u>Commonwealth Heritage List</u>.

Under paragraph 10.03C Section 341S of the EPBC Act, comments are invited on the draft Historic Heritage Management Plan from members of the public, Traditional Owners with rights and interests in the area, key stakeholders and community groups by close of business 2 November 2025 (20 days after which the last notice is published).
