

ROVER guide: How to apply to import an Interim SEVs vehicle

How to apply to import an Interim SEVs vehicle

Before you can apply for an Interim SEVs vehicle, you first need to create an account in ROVER, the department's online applications and approvals portal.

Instructions on how to create a ROVER account are available here.

Recommended browsers

The recommended browsers to use when accessing ROVER are: <u>Chrome</u>, <u>Firefox</u> or <u>Microsoft Edge</u>. Internet Explorer and Safari are not recommended.

Authority to act

To act on behalf of someone else – including a registered automotive workshop (RAW) organisation – you must also register an authority to act for that organisation. Instructions on how to create an authority to act are available here.

Starting your application

Once your account and authority to act are created, you can start your application.


Note: All applications for Interim SEVs vehicles must be made by the RAW, or on behalf of the RAW, that will be modifying the vehicle and providing the vehicle inspection certificate (VIC).

Step 1.

sign in to ROVER.


Step 2.

Under the New Applications tab, select Apply for a Single Road Vehicle approval (concessional RAV, Non-RAV, reimportation) to start your application.



Step 3.

Answer the initial questions and when prompted, confirm you are seeking approval for a Vehicle covered by an entry on the Specialist and Enthusiast Vehicle (SEVs) Register.




Step 4.

Enter the vehicle's details. There is no need to enter the **DSEV** prefix that is required in the VIC. If you are entering a Chassis number, please remove any hyphens. For example, E50-4561234 should be entered as E504561234.

Fields marked with a * must be filled in.

Tip: Make sure you click on the **Edit** button first.



Step 5.


On the **Required supporting material** page, enter the following details:

- Name of Model Report holder = Interim SEVs modified by RAW 10XXX
- Model Report approval number = NA + provide explanation
- SEVs Register entry number = NA + provide explanation <u>and</u> DSEVs entry number.

The system will show a warning, but you can save and continue anyway.

Answer the question on which country the vehicle is being imported from and upload any further supporting information and photos of the vehicle you want approved.

Tip: Make sure you untick the blue Upload supporting files boxes before saving (see below).



Step 6.

Answer the remaining questions in the application, submit and pay the application fee. Applications may take up to 30 business days to approve.

Note: The definition of a **business day** under section 5 of the Rules: Means a day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday in the Australian Capital Territory.

If you meet the relevant criteria, you will be provided a concessional RAV entry approval with conditions. Concessional RAV entry approval also serves as an import approval.

Step 8.

One of the conditions on the approval will be that you send the department a VIC once the vehicle has been modified in accordance with an evidence pack. Send the VIC to the department through the RAWS system. Ensure you include the CRE approval number and check that the vehicle identification number (VIN) is identical to that document.

If you are making a concessional RAV entry application because you have a vehicle with a previous import approval – but you did not receive identification plate approval before 30 June 2021 – you may submit your VIC through the RAWS system at the same time you make your ROVER application.

Step 9.

After the VIC has been approved, your vehicle will be entered onto the Register of Approved Vehicles (RAV) and can be provided to the owner or to the market.

This vehicle will be cancelled from the RAWS system upon RAV entry, therefore no record of the VIN will appear in the RAWS system after approval.
