RVS legislation fees, charges and payments

The Australian Government recovers the costs of activities related to the administration of the Road Vehicle Standards (RVS) legislation from industry participants, consistent with the Australian Government Charging Framework.

The fees we charge for approval applications reflect the actual cost of processing applications.

The <u>Cost Recovery Implementation Statement</u> provides information on how the department undertakes cost recovery arrangements for administrative and regulatory activities under the RVS legislation.

Varying an approved application

In determining whether an application fee will apply to a variation application, the department considers material changes to be those that either:

- increase or change the scope of an approval, with the exception of changes that reduce the scope of what an approval holder can do under the RVS legislation, or
- seek to remove or reduce restrictions the department has previously applied as part of an approval.

The department generally does not charge application fees when you make a variation application to ensure your approval is compliant with revised Australian Design Rules (ADRs).

The decision notice will advise you if an application fee is payable. In cases where a fee is payable, the varied approval will not take effect or be published until the fee is paid.

Your current approval will remain in effect until the assessment fee is paid and you are advised that the department has applied the changes to your approval.

Please note that you will be unable to request further variations to an approval while you have an unpaid application fee.

^{**} Approvals do not come into force until the first annual levy has been paid. Subsequent annual levies become due and payable on the anniversary of the first levy payment date.

How do I pay?

Payments need to be made through ROVER.

When you submit your application ROVER will prompt you to pay via the online payment system. The department currently accepts payments via credit/debit card (Visa or MasterCard).

If no payment is made after 60 days you will be sent a reminder email. Once payment is confirmed your application will proceed to assessment and the status will be updated to 'In progress'.

Applications are not complete until the application fee has been paid and will not be considered until your payment has been received.
