Amendment to the Telecommunications (Statutory Infrastructure Providers — Circumstances for Exceptions to Connection and Supply Obligations) Determination 2021

Thank you for the opportunity to comment the proposed amendment to the Telecommunications (Statutory Infrastructure Providers — Circumstances for Exceptions to Connection and Supply Obligations) Determination 2021 (the Instrument).

As you are aware, my office is currently developing our process for handling complaints that involve statutory infrastructure providers (SIP). As part of our complaint handling, we would consider the exceptions listed in the Instrument for when a SIP could reasonably refuse a connection or supply request.

If the Instrument is to sunset on 28 May 2024 as proposed, we would benefit from early consultation and notice on options to replace the Instrument. This would ensure we can prepare for any changes and our handling of relevant complaints is not impacted when the Instrument sunsets.
