


# Your mobile and internet services could stop working during a natural disaster.

There are 6 steps you can take to make sure your community is prepared:



Have a portable battery-powered radio with a spare set of batteries



Charge your mobile phone and have a spare battery pack



Keep a paper copy of your family and friends' contact details



Get to know your neighbours and find out where you can go for help if you need it



Have some cash on hand for emergencies



Tell your friends and family about your emergency plans before you need to act on them

**If you find yourself without telecommunications in an emergency, don't wait for a warning. Get ready and leave early if you think the situation is getting worse.**
