Baggage became stuck in the aircraft hold, and it required an engineer to troubleshoot and fix the issue. The aircraft was then required to wait for another inbound aircraft to land before it could take-off, causing a further delay. A dispensation was granted for landing no later than 23:30 local time. JQ724 had 172 passengers including 9 children, 2 infants, 1 passenger requiring assistance and 6 crew onboard. The aircraft arrived at 23:07 local time.

Further delays occurred in flight due to strong headwinds. A dispensation was granted for landing no later than 23:15 local time. QF749 had 144 passengers and 6 crew onboard with cargo including 10kg of blood products. The aircraft arrived at 23:02 local time.

An engineer was required to enter the incident on the Minimum Equipment List and complete checks. A dispensation was granted for landing no later than 23:40 local time. JQ689 had 205 passengers including 5 children, 4 infants, 1 passenger requiring a wheelchair and 7 crew onboard. The aircraft arrived at 23:22 local time.
