Our input is our concern with our island state Tasmania and any major changes that this document includes, an immediate subsidy of those areas would be required.

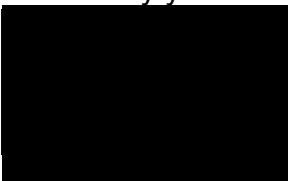
Covid 19 illustrated to the Australian people, the importance Heavy and light vehicle transport, about the delivery of essential services.
