## Update on JBT water pipeline

Following the busy holiday period, works have recommenced on the water pipeline project, with the contractor working on installing the new re-chlorination building and other infrastructure works at Stoney Creek. The pipeline and reservoirs will then be cleaned before being filled with water from the new system. The project remains on track to be completed by the end of March 2026.

The pipeline is being delivered through a partnership between the Australian Government and Shoalhaven City Council.

With the current JBT water treatment plant reaching the end of its life the new pipeline will connect JBT's water to the established Shoalhaven water supply. This will provide a more sustainable and reliable source of water and improve potable water quality for the community.

We will keep the JBT community informed as works wrap up and the water supply is switched over.
