### Water Pipeline Construction Update

Construction of the new water pipeline, connecting Jervis Bay Territory (JBT) to the neighbouring Shoalhaven water network, is progressing well along the New South Wales section of the route. Pre-construction works are now under way within JBT. This critical infrastructure project will deliver a more sustainable and reliable water supply for JBT, improving water quality and supporting future community needs.



Residents may begin to notice increased activity in the area, with contractors marking the pipeline route and services as well as conducting geotechnical tests. These activities may include some traffic control to undertake the work safely. An example of the service identification activity is shown in this photo.

Once construction is under way within JBT, there will be traffic impacts near the construction zone. These impacts will be due to closing one lane for construction and will move as the work progresses.

Construction within JBT will not be taking place until after the upcoming school holidays have concluded (after 10 October 2025) to minimise impacts for residents and tourists during that time.

The Australian Government and our project partners Shoalhaven City Council and Quickway Constructions will provide the community and local stakeholders with regular updates through the construction period, including information on traffic management. Every effort will be made to minimize disruption. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we deliver this important infrastructure upgrade.
