On behalf of the Australian Warbirds Association's roughly 450 members, I thank you for the time, effort, and consideration you've put into the Aviation Safety Regulatory Review. It's our opinion that the results outline several good common-sense recommendations that, if implemented, should improve the operating environment for Australia's aviation sector and go a long ways towards restoring trust in the Regulator the findings noted as lacking.

Our main concern at present is that the recommendations will not be acted upon. We feel this would be a grave mistake and missed opportunity if the Department were to disregard the findings. The Panel's report seemed to us to be unequivocal in outlining the deficiencies that exist in CASA and their relationship with the aviation sector. It is our hope the Minister sees these as well with a sense of urgency and implements the changes as recommended.
